- Include the flyer with any information provided at appointment check-ins
- Post it at your check-in window and in visible locations in your waiting room
- Post it in examination rooms
- Post it in your laboratories, infusion centers, and any other diagnostic or treatment areas where people may experience a wait time
- Post it in all common areas of your facility, such as lobbies and cafeterias
